## Symptoms Screener

The safety, health and well-being of our students, staff, families and community is a top priority. The NC DHHS StrongSchoolsNC toolkit requires public schools to conduct a COVID-19 symptom screening and temperature check of any person entering a school building. For this reason, we will be asking each student and visitor to complete the CCS Symptoms Screener survey each day before reporting to school.

Step 1



Each morning, the CCS Symptoms Screener will come to your CCS student email address with a link to complete the survey or you can access a link on the CCS website: www.ccs.k12.nc.us.

Step 2



In order for your child to board a CCS bus, you must complete the parent attestation question included in the electronic survey. This attestation question must be completed once for each child, prior to riding the bus.

Step 3



Select the preferred language option to complete the CCS Symptoms Screener Survey.

Step 4



Please be as honest as possible when answering all three survey questions related to possible COVID-19 exposure and symptoms.

Step 5



Based on your responses, you will either see a green checkmark enabling you to go to school or a red x mark with further instructions. Please remember to screenshot the "approved" message on your phone/device to show to school staff each morning as this will aid in a smooth entry each day.



Thank you for your cooperation and support! The purpose of the CCS Symptoms Screener survey is to determine if you are currently experiencing symptoms related to COVID-19 or have recently been exposed to COVID-19. All information provided is kept confidential. Based on your survey results, you will be approved to go to school or will be asked to stay at home. Students who are not feeling well should stay home and consult with a physician or health care provider. Students who develop symptoms during the school day will need to be picked up.
