

Raleigh Road Reading Rodeo




Welcome to the 2023-2024 Reading Rodeo! It is important that you read with your child every day. At first, you may be reading to your child. Later in the year, your child should begin reading to you. This folder is where you will record all of the reading you and your child do at home. As students achieve milestones, they will be recognized on the morning announcements, receive charms, and will be given a certificate of achievement. Students who read at least 20 books each month will also receive a certificate for a free personal pizza from Pizza Hut as part of the BOOK IT program. Parent approval is required to participate in the BOOK IT program.

Student Milestone Charms

100 Books Read- Students will receive a 100 charm for their necklace.

200-400 Books Read- Students will receive a green bead for reading 200 books and an additional green bead for each 100 read after the 200 (up to 400).



Things to Remember

- 1. You and your child should read together at least 20 mins each night. Your child needs your help to become a better reader.
- 2. Ask your child questions about the book you read. This helps children understand what they are reading and recall facts.
- 3. The parent/guardian should record all information on the recording sheet and initial. When reading a chapter book, one chapter counts as one book.
- 4. Books should be read three times for understanding, but each book should only be recorded once in the folder. Quality over quantity! \bigcirc
- 5. If you wish for your student to read more than 500 books, please understand that there are no more rewards or incentives for going past the 500 book milestone.
- 6. Return your child's Reading Rodeo folder to school daily. Folders will be totaled each week on Thursday. Books read on Friday and over the weekend will be counted the following week. Please keep the folder up to date- credit will not be given for backdated books.
- 7. Students who reach milestones will participate in our End of Year Reading Rodeo Celebration Week May 6-10! *Reading Rodeo will end Friday April 26, 2024
- **Optional reading activities are available for students to pick up at the library. These include the Master Bookworm Challenge and the Book of the Week Book Review.**
