| 1      | Can you please tell me more or elaborate on this digital curriculum the district is looking for? Is it for both ELA and Math? | Looking for centralized online credit recovery and first-time credit course programs for middle and high school students that support all subject areas.  |
| 2      | Are you looking for test prep tools?  | Yes, that is a component  |
| 3      | Do you require a tool to provide instruction through virtual modules independent of a teacher?                                | Yes   |
| 4      | Will you award multiple vendors?  | Our goal is to select one vendor. In the event that we are not able to select a vendor, we will consider multiple.  |
| 5      | Does Cumberland County Schools plan to use district teachers, vendor teachers, or a mix of both?                              | We plan to use a mix of both district and vendor teachers depending on the needs of students.   |
| 6      | How many students are you looking to serve virtually at your traditional high schools for credit recovery and initial credit? | Our initial data shows that we would immediately serve about 3,000 high school students who may need a mix of credit recovery or initial credit.
