Timetable for the Project

It is the Owner's intent to make a recommendation regarding award of these Contracts by <u>May 14, 2021</u>. A Notice of Intent to Award will be prepared and conveyed to the Contractor immediately. The Contractor shall commence the performance of this Contract and shall diligently continue its performance to and until final completion of the Project. Project shall start on <u>June 1, 2021</u>, and contractor shall have <u>50 days</u> to complete the project, making the final completion date <u>July 21, 2021</u>. Schedule of construction must be coordinated with school personnel.

Insurance

The Contractor shall provide, as required by law, insurance for his employees. The Cumberland County Schools assumes no liability for injuries or accidents related to the contractual agreement. The Contractor shall furnish Certificate of Insurance to the Owner as proof of coverage. The Contractor shall maintain and pay for Insurance coverage and shall not be less than the following:

A. Workman's Compensation Statutory Employers Liability \$500,000

B. General Liability (per person/per occurrence):

1. Bodily and Personal Liability \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000

2. Property Damage \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000 Aggregate

C. Automobile Liability (per person/per occurrence)
1. Bodily Injury \$1,000,000

2. Property Damage: \$1,000,000 Aggregate

Certificates of Insurance shall be filed with the Owner. During construction of the work, the Contractor shall provide updated records whenever any of these coverages become outdated.

Each certificate of insurance shall bear the provision that the policy cannot be canceled or coverage reduced or eliminated in less than thirty (30) days after mailing to the insured and/or the Owner of such

alteration or cancellation. The certificate holder shall be named: Attn: Joe Desormeaux, Cumberland County Board of Education, P.O. Box 2357, Fayetteville, NC 28302.

Performance

The Contractor shall commence work to be performed under the Contract on a date to be specified in a Notice to Proceed issued by the Owner and shall substantially complete all work in accordance with the project Time Table. If the Contractor fails to begin the work within ten days after the date specified in the Notice to Proceed, or progress of the work is not maintained on schedule, or the Contractor fails to perform the work with sufficient workmen and equipment or with sufficient materials to ensure prompt completion of the work, or shall perform the work unsuitably, or not in accordance with plans and specifications, or in violation of safety requirements or for any cause whatsoever shall not carry on the work in an acceptable manner, then the Owner shall declare this Contract in default and Owner may terminate the performance of the Contract and assume possession of the Project site and of all materials and equipment at the site and may complete the work. In such case, the Contractor shall not be paid until the work is complete. After Final Completion has been achieved, if any portion of the contract price, as it may be modified thereunder, remains after the cost to the Owner of completing the work, including all costs and expenses of every nature incurred, has been deducted by the Owner, such remainder shall belong to the Contractor. Otherwise, the Contractor shall pay and make whole the Owner for such cost. This obligation for payment shall survive the termination of the Contract. Failure of a Contractor to meet the requirements of a Contract and/or insufficient performance may disqualify Contractor from bidding future Projects.

Warranty

The Warranty for work and materials by the Contractor shall be for a period of one-year from date of acceptance of the Project by the Owner.

Description:

Replace ceiling tile and grid in administration area and media center.

SCOPE OF WORK

- 1. Contractor to remove existing ceiling tiles and grid.
- 2. Contractor will coordinate with owner for light fixture removal and replacement.
- 3. Contractor will install new acoustical ceiling tiles and grid, including hanger wires for lights.

Specifications: Ceiling tiles – Armstrong 1728 - 24" x 24" x 5/8" lay-in tiles

Grid and suspension system -

- A. Comply with requirements of ASTM C 635 and C 636 as applicable to the suspended acoustical tile ceilings system materials indicated.
- B. Corrosion protection: Provide finishes as indicated, but in no case less than required ASTM C 635 for normal use environments.
- C. Attachment devices: Type recommended by suspension system manufacturer for attachment or anchorage of ceiling hangers to structure above ceiling, sized for not less than 5 times the hanger design load for the structural classification indicated; ASTM C 635, Table 1, Direct Hung

D. Hanger wire:

- 1. Galvanized carbon steel wire, ASTM A 641, soft temper, pre-stretched, class 1 coating
- 2. Gauge: Provide wire sized so that strength is 3 times hanger design load

Provide 18ga galvanized wire to hang recessed lighting fixtures, 2 per each fixture as indicated on plan. Light hangers are to be distinguishable from grid system hangers.

- E. Provide "T" bar supports for recessed lights
- F. Type of system: standard, direct -hung suspension system (15/16')
- G. Exposure of system:
 - 1. Provide exposed suspension system with main runners spaced and exposed as indicated.
 - 2. Provide concealed spline system as indicated
 - 3. Provide exposed moldings for support at edges of ceiling, at walls and columns with a single flange of molding exposed. Angle molding shall be 3/4" x 3/4" x .62; finish to match runners.
- H. Finish of exposed members: Provide uniform, factory applied finish on an exposed surface of ceiling suspension system including moldings, trim, and accessories, to match ceiling tile color.
- 4. Contractor will avoid damage to any fixtures, registers, ductwork and other equipment.
- 5. Contractor is responsible for disposal of all materials.
- 6. Contractor is responsible for providing own lift or scaffolding
- 7. Contractor will check in each day at office before starting work.
- 8. Contractor will keep work area safe and clean at all times
