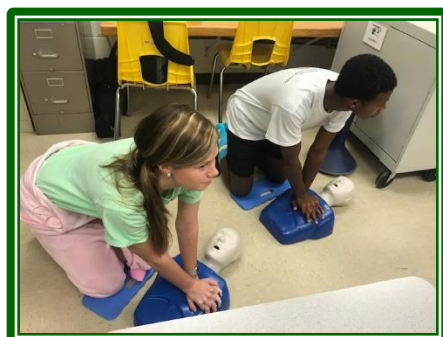


Are you interested in a future career in medicine or health care?
