Start Date:

- ❖ The first day of school, for students, will be Monday, July 15th 2024.
- ❖ Students are expected to be in their homeroom classes no later than 7:25 AM.
- ❖ Students who come to school after 7:25 am, will be required to be signed in by their parent(s)/guardian(s).
- ❖ Dismissal is at 2:40 pm. Checkouts are not prohibited after 2 pm.
- ❖ We check I.D. 100% of the time! We will NOT release students and/or student information to anyone that is not designated in PowerSchool.

ACMS Uniform Policy:

- ❖ **ALL students will be required to purchase a lock from ACMS for \$7.** All students will be required to have a locker assigned to them, and ALL belongings to include electronics will be required to be placed in the lockers with the exception of laptop and laptop bag provided by the school. Students will not be allowed to carry purses, or bags of any kind that are not issued by the school. These items must be placed in the lockers. Students will be provided an opportunity to access items necessary for class, lunch, PE, and the restroom.
