- Complete <u>application</u> form (in-district and out-of-district students)
- II. Write one page essay (topic content stated on application form)
- III. Complete Choice Program Application (out-of-district students only)
- IV. Obtain two faculty **recommendations**
- V. Earn a minimum **GPA of 2.5** (must maintain a 3.0 in academy courses)
- VI. Provide academic record (Rising 9th graders copy of 8th grade report card; rising 10th a copy of your last transcript if you are a transfer in student)



Additional AOHS Requirements

These additional requirements will be met over your tenure in the academy and instructions for completing will be given by your academy instructors.

- Complete work-based learning/community service hours (200; adjusted based on grade level entry into the program)
- II. Join HOSA
- III. Wear AOHS uniform on specified days and occasions
- IV. Maintain requirements for the district, school and classroom teachers' rules and procedures as outlined by the code of conduct
