High School - NCVPS Classes (Asynch)



1st Semester

Students who had an NCVPS class in the 1st semester continue attending the class until January 10th



2nd Semester

AP classes start January 3rd. All other classes start January 17th.

High School - Credit Recovery Classes

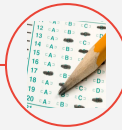
Core Classes Only



Student must have previously taken and failed the class with a teacher



If it's an EOC class (Bio, E2, M1, M3), they must have previously taken the EOC



Final grade cannot be below 40% in the class previously



High School - Credit Recovery Classes

Asynchronous Classes, no teacher, self-paced/self taught



Students receive a Pass/Fail for final grade



Students and Guardians submit a Google Form to complete enrollment



Great way to catch up on graduation requirements



High School Schedule Correction Request

Classes can only be changed for the following reasons:

- 1) You need a required course not on your schedule
- 2) You need to repeat a class that you failed
- 3) Already taken and received credit for a class on your schedule
- 4) 2 classes in the same period and same semester (Your schedule does not need to be changed if both classes are FTCC classes or Credit Recovery)
- 5) Schedule is incomplete (not enough classes)
- 6) Missing a prerequisite class (Ex: Spanish 2 is scheduled but have not taken/passed Spanish 1)
- 7) Request Reduced Schedule - Seniors only - Must be in good standing and have parent permission emailed to Ms. Matthews





High School Schedule Correction Request

- We cannot make schedule changes because a student wants to swap class periods or teachers
- Please do not submit a request through email. You must submit the Google Form
- We will automatically adjust schedules in January for students who fail a core class 1st semester

- Parent will be notified for excessive excused absences. To provide documentation (medical or ect.)
- Students and parents are required to attend an attendance conference (Administration & School Social Worker)

ASK INSTITUTE FUNDAMENTALS OF MARKETING EXAM

All students completing Marketing & Marketing Applications are eligible to take the nationally recognized ASK Institute Fundamentals of Marketing Exam offered by MBA Research & Curriculum Center. This exam is based on industry validated standards and can provide credentials used to move forward in the workplace or educational programs. Cumberland County Schools Career & Technical Education Department pays the exam fee for each eligible student. This exam is offered at the completion of the 2nd level Marketing Applications course.

The exam for this semester will be offered on Dec 11, 2023 at the Educational Resource Center located at 396 Elementary Drive. The arrival time will be 8:00 am with the test beginning no later than 8:30 am. Since this is a voluntary exam, students will be expected to provide their own transportation to and from the test.

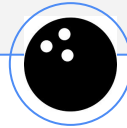

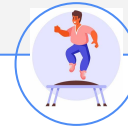
