In an effort to ensure the continued safety of all students and staff, and the security of our buildings and facilities, Cumberland County Schools has implemented The School Angels Watch volunteer program. This unique program offers the community the opportunity to become involved at the school level to do their part to help keep our children and our schools safe.

- Volunteers in the School Angels Watch Program must be 21 years of age or older.
- He/she must be able to pass a background check and be committed to the safety and well-being of the students and staff in the Cumberland County Schools.
- Volunteers can be community leaders, retirees, parents, and church and civic organization leaders who want to make a difference in the community.
- School Angels will be considered non-paid school employees
- School Angels will communicate via radio to report any and all suspicious activity to school administrators. Additionally, School Angels will check to ensure all gates and fences are secure and will work to ensure other Safety and Security measures are being followed.
- Volunteers will receive training prior to being placed at a school.
- Keep in mind that this is an outdoor position, not inside at all.
